## New Sunshades at Bay Walk Park

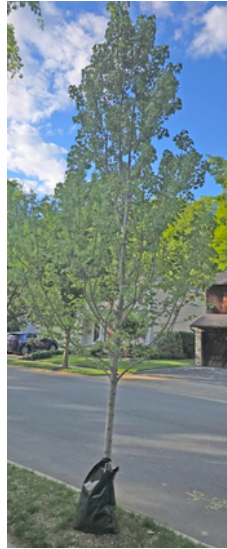
The Village of Port Washington North is pleased to announce the installation of new and updated sunshades at Bay Walk Park.

## 20 New Trees Planted Throughout the Village

We're proud to announce the successful planting of 20 new trees throughout the Village of Port Washington North. This initiative helps enhance the beauty of our community while providing long-term environmental benefits, including improved air quality, increased shade, stormwater management, and healthier green spaces for future generations.

You may notice the bag that is at the base of the tree in the photograph. That is referred to as a gator bag. Its purpose is to provide water to newly planted trees. We are asking any homeowners that have a new tree planted in front of their house to please refill the bags when the water runs out to ensure healthy growth. There is an opening at the top that allows a watering can or a water hose to slip into the bag and allow it to be refilled. Doing this for the next month or so will help the tree grow strong and retain their leaves in the heat.

Thank you to everyone involved in helping make our Village greener, stronger, and more sustainable. We look forward to watching these trees grow alongside our community for years to come. 🌱🌳
